1. **[Discussion + Action]** - F-Building Furniture and Mural,
 - a. Blaisdell Representative will get back to Director Rashada within the next two weeks. She is prioritizing the ASCOA meeting room space. No action taken.
2. **[Discussion]** - Volunteer Opportunities
 - a. One COA Outreach Specialist and ASCOA Volunteers will represent COA at the Discover Alameda Business Expo and Career Fair on September 17th. The event starts at 3:30pm until 7 pm.
3. **[Discussion]** - Future Events.
 - a. VPP Reyes will center future events to be culturally relevant to COA's demographics. He will plan for one event per month with the main focus on event content, not so much on food.
