Guided Pathways (GP)	Team	<p>President Jones reminded that the College is moving forward with implementing the Fields of Study in the College's Guided Pathways (GP) efforts in a more sustainable way and accelerated manner. We want to make sure that we are making available to our students the transformative benefits of higher education. We are in the process of finalizing the agreement for our participation in the CAGP 2.0. The College of Alameda current GP team participated in 3 day virtual institute.</p> <p>Planning session is forthcoming. We have been building a foundation for the College's GP plan, now we need to put our plan into action. This year's GP Leads are Maurice Jones, Marissa Nakano and Julie Saechao.</p> <p>The College has worked on GP for several years; the maps are the key to students' success. All of COA</p>	Information

		<p>Counselors have the maps and utilize them.</p> <p>GP accelerates student success, especially for the most impacted student population.</p> <p>A majority of our students expect to advance their careers through education; connecting not just the maps, but how the education leads to livable wage career. We need to help them see what's possible. On average college students are taking 90 units, whereas only 60 are required. We need to help them figure out, in much more efficient way, how to optimize their time and experience at the College. We need to critically look at our processes; they may not be student friendly. This is an opportunity for us to be self-reflecting and continue to learn and improve in a cyclical process.</p> <p>Part-time student maps are needed.</p>	
6. Accreditation	Jones/Vasconcellos	<p>President Jones informed that the ACCJC virtual site visit in October (10/18-19, 2021) went well; the draft team report has been received. We are waiting on the Commission's decision in January (1/12-14, 2022). A request to appear before the Commission has been made.</p> <p>The tone and tenor of the report is very encouraging. Continued leadership (Chancellor) and the new management addition, Deputy Chancellor, are going to be very helpful to the Peralta Colleges' Accreditation efforts.</p>	Information
7. Return to Campus	Jones/Vasconcellos	<p>President Jones informed that a more robust in person return to campus is expected, starting in the Spring 2022 term. We need to finalize some of the work (air flow, sanitation, etc.). 35-40% of course offerings will be hybrid or face-to-face. In-person student services as well as instructional support services will be available on average 3 days; the remaining time will be virtual.</p>	Information

		Enrollment for the in-person classes will be monitored daily. We will continue to follow county and CDC guidelines.	
8. Education Master Plan (EMP)	Jones	Dr Jones shared that the topic will be discussed in a future meeting in more details. The original plan to begin the EMP process is delayed. District Strategic Plan as well as the District's Environmental scan are needed as they will be helpful and informative in updating our EMP. A new proposed timeline will be forthcoming.	Information
