2. Guided Pathways – Trish Nelson

ADT's ready to be put into catalogs. AA's are next.

Over winter, went through program maps and made inventory to determine what metamajors might look like. Ex: I'm a faculty in AfrAm and I can see what degrees need (requested) AfrAm 30. Can use some of the GP work to inform discipline plans. Can know which courses colleagues are asking for and when (i.e. which semester).

What's next, put "globs"/groups of classes together and see what students can call them. Don: Updates for Scale of Adoption (what have we been doing, where do we project to be/have completed in next couple of years) to send to State Chancellor's office which is due March 1, 2020. Can have discussion with Senate if there's glaring errors.

Title V says need to maintain instructor-student and student-student contact.

Zoom:

- sign up using Peralta email bc State Chancellor's office gives all faculty Pro Zoom account.
- Tip: After sign up, go to profile and customize zoom "personal link" to use something closer to your name. Can also edit Personal meeting ID to cell phone (or work phone)



- Under settings: click meeting (basic), click participants video is default turned on. For students, this default setting turned off might be better for students so they can choose to turn on their camera when they want.
- Under settings: click meeting (basic), select join before host on. This allows students to enter the room before you (the host) joins the room.
- Under settings: click meeting (basic), select screen sharing as on. This allows participants to share their own screen. This also allows the host the possibility of remote controlling the participants' screen.
- Under settings: click recording, turn cloud recording on. Zoom will transcribe the meeting, creating captions and subtitles. It's about 90% accurate, so you'll need to edit the captions.

Students don't need to sign up. They just use your zoom link.

5. VPI Updates – *Don Miller*

a. Program appraisal & continuance
AP4021 – not about deleting an entire discipline. It's about programs. Ex: vacuum
tubes program existed, yet there was a tenured faculty member; that faculty
member was teaching in another discipline/department, but college discontinued
the vacuum tube program. Does a program need updating or is it no longer
relevant? Example: If you've developed 10 different certificates and look through
program review and other data points, you may see that students have graduated
with only 4 certificates. This is a good example of where you'd update the
certificates and discontinue the 6 where students did not receive certificates.
Discussion guidelines are found in item D in AP4021.

Major work lies in Academic Senate and the Curriculum committee. Connected to program review. Links to state guidelines for curriculum: every 2 years for CE, every 3 years for GE and transfer programs. There is a 39-page fillable form regarding this. There is also a rubric that curriculum committee uses to make a determination of continuance, conditional continuance, discontinuance or program consolidation.
