SUBJECT: Guided Pathways

MEMORANDUM

The State of California's \$150 million one-time investment in the Guided Pathways Award Program will give each of our 114 colleges the opportunity to begin implementation of the Guided Pathways framework. This investment will support an intensive five-year planning and implementation process at each participating college. Using the Guided Pathways framework, colleges will rethink and redesign programs and services into cohesive, campus-wide strategies to achieve the outcomes expected by the state, our system, and our students.

The State Chancellor's Office has developed a two phase process for Colleges to access these funds.

Self-Assessment (Phase 1)

Guided Pathway Self-Assessment Plan is due on December 23, 2017. The workshop in October will focus on the plan. The Academic Senate President is one of the certification signatures. The plan also goes to the Board of Trustees. The vetting steps are:

- October 12: PRIEC Committee
- October 19: Academic Senate Presentation
- October 23: Guided Pathways Workshop (Bring Draft Assessment Plan)
- October 25: College Council
- November 16: Academic Senate
- November 21: PREIC Committee
- November 27: Due date to submit board items
- December 6: College Council
- December 12: Board Approval
- December 15: Send to State Chancellor's Office
