3. New Business / Discussion Items: Proposed Math GE Requirement – Local (VP)

The GE Subcommittee discussed allowing students to use their High School Transcript. Currently, students must have Intermediate Algebra at the colleges, so that students with Trig of above on their transcript must retake Intermediate Algebra. The proposal is to allow students to use High School Intermediate Algebra or higher to satisfy our local GE requirement. After the discussion at Curriculum Committee, the conversation will move to Chairs and Academic Senate; the GE subcommittee will take it back up in April or May 2023.

- LD: In the past student have gotten credit, so what's the difference: VP: Students now submit a substitution form to the chair. This proposal makes it automatic based on the HS Transcript. LD: Counselors are doing it now; will that change? VP: No, this formalizes it. LD: Will this impact Math course enrollment? VP: This is just speaking to the GE requirement. It allows HS Xcript to clear the math requirements. LD: Students might not actually know the material even if they have an A on the transcript. I guess I'd be against this. MG: This is different from the Computer Literacy case; we'd need to hear back from Math and other disciplines before we make a move. VP: This would be a district-wide AP change. MJ: I echo Linda and Matt; what we have, the challenge form, I think is good; faculty look at it and make the determination. VP: I will take this to the other constituent groups for feedback then report back to the GE group next year.
