Complete the Adult/High School Special Enrollment Form

Once you receive your Peralta Student ID number, complete the Adult/High School Special Enrollment Form.

Meet with your high school counselor to choose the course/s you'd like to take and for their signature. Note: If you are under 18 years old, a parent signature is also required.
