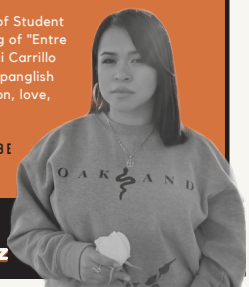
IDENTITY WORKSHOP & BOOK READING
