Dr. Connie Weyhenmeyer presented a proposal to create a new Environmental Science discipline at the College of Alameda. Seeking to first establish the ENVS discipline before proposing courses. Peralta does not currently have an environmental science discipline. At CoA, environmental science courses (e.g. BIOL 102: Oceanography) are currently listed under biology. Environmental Science is a discipline distinct from Biology, Environmental Studies or Sustainability. Discussion followed.
